Creative Spaces Mentoring Network



Program Overview | 2020-21

The Creative Spaces Mentoring Network (CSMN) is provided to cultural leaders in Ontario's arts sector. Leaders in Ontario's arts sector who are responsible for their facilities or capital-related issues have the opportunity to access one-to-one learning with an experienced professional, providing knowledge and expertise related to their space projects. The program focuses on strengthening business and management skills needed to successfully oversee, renew and develop creative spaces. The 2020-21 program will be the sixth iteration of CSMN.

Through the Creative Spaces Mentoring Network, ArtsBuild Ontario (ABO) matches arts and cultural leaders with experienced mentors from the arts or other relevant sectors. Once mentoring teams are confirmed, they will meet at the Kick-Off Webinar and afterwards begin meeting; mentors and mentees will meet for up to three hours monthly over 12 months to focus on developing skills and knowledge related to the mentee's focus areas.

Such focus areas include, but are not limited to:

- Creating accessible spaces
- Indigenous creative spaces
- Property management and or leasing
- Community relationships and strategic partnerships
- Marketing, communications and promotions
- Human resources
- Finances, fundraising and capital campaigns
- Community engagement
- Municipal and government relations

Participants and their organizations can benefit in many ways from this program. Participants will gain:

- Improved business strategies
- Management and leadership skills
- Confidence
- Decision-making skills
- Communication strategies
- Networking opportunities and contacts

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ABO will train and support the mentoring teams so that they get the most out of the program by developing and providing:

- A Kick-Off Webinar, Mid-Program Workshop/Webinar, and a Wrap-Up Webinar
- Training materials and Mentoring support
- Networking opportunities
